**DR. CHARLES KUNTZ**  
DVM, MS, MACVSc

Dr. Charles Kuntz graduated with a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine from the University of Florida in 1990. He went on to a rotating small animal internship at the Animal Medical Center in New York City. In 1994, he completed a surgical residency and Master's degree at Virginia Tech. Following that, he did a fellowship in Cardiac Surgery at Auburn University. He became a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons. Charles did an 18 month research fellowship in Surgical Oncology and became an Assistant Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery, both at Colorado State University.

In 2004, Charles moved to Australia where he started Southpaws Specialty Surgery for Animals. He was made an ACVS Founding Fellow of Surgical Oncology in 2012.

He currently works at the Animal Emergency and Specialist Centre as a senior consultant.

His areas of interest include surgical oncology, minimally invasive surgery and neurosurgery. He also finds passion in international teaching in persona and through his YouTube channel VetDojo. He most enjoys spending time with his wife, three sons, and his Labrador Retriever, Humphrey.

**DR. MÁRCIO BERNSTEIN**  
DVM, MS, MACVSc

Dr. Márcio Bernstein is a Veterinarian and the only Specialist in Veterinary Nephrology and Urology, officially recognized by the Federal Council of Veterinary Medicine (CFMV) in Brazil. He is the founder and director of RENALVET – Center for Veterinary Nephrology, Urology, and Hemodialysis, established in 2001 as the first institution of its kind in South America. With over 38 years of clinical experience, Dr. Bernstein has dedicated his career to advancing kidney care and dialysis treatments for animals of all sizes—from companion pets to exotic species, including camels, dromedaries, and the royal horses of Jordan. Internationally recognized as a pioneer in veterinary hemodialysis, he has led the establishment of pioneering services in Europe (Portugal), the Middle East (Dubai), and Asia (India).

Graduated in Veterinary Medicine in 1987, Dr. Bernstein began studying acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine in 1984 and became the first South American veterinarian certified by the International Veterinary Acupuncture Society (IVAS). His training in human Traditional Chinese Medicine in the United States further enhanced his integrative approach to animal health.

A passionate educator and lecturer, Dr. Bernstein has presented and taught at universities and international congresses across Brazil, the United States, Europe, the Middle East, and Asia, sharing his expertise in veterinary nephrology, urology, and hemodialysis.

Through RENALVET's expanding international network in Colombia, Portugal, Dubai, India, and Brazil, Dr. Márcio Bernstein continues to lead innovation and excellence in veterinary renal medicine worldwide.

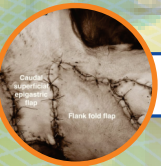

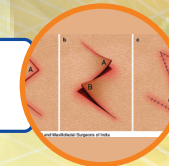

## Mandu



Floating over its own reflection, the Jahaz Mahal in Mandu looks like a ship that's about to sail. However, for centuries this ship made of stone and mortar never did. Instead,

In Mandu, temperatures can often soar to 45 degrees in summer. That's perhaps why the anonymous Afghan architect who built the Jahaz Mahal combined conservation of water and systems of rain water harvesting with the beauty and delicacy of Islamic architecture.

## Omkareswar

Among the 12 Jyotirlinga shrines, this holy island is shaped like the holiest of all Hindu symbols, the 'Om', by mother nature herself. The island comprises of lofty hills, between which, river Narmada forms a serene pool.

As per Hindu legend, Vindya, the deity controlling the Vindyaachal mountain range was worshipping Shiva to propitiate himself from the sins committed.
